AAUW is open to college or university graduates with an Associate, Baccalaureate or higher degree. Affiliate memberships are available for students and non-graduates.

OUR FOCUS...

- ✓ **The AAUW Education Foundation (EF)** is the world's largest source of funding exclusively for graduate women. Each year the EF provides about \$4 million in fellowships, grants and awards for outstanding women around the globe and for community action projects. The EF also funds pioneering research on women, girls and education.
- ✓ **The AAUW Legal Advocacy Fund (LAF)**, is the nation's largest legal fund focused solely on sex discrimination in higher education. The LAF provides funds and a support system for women seeking judicial redress for sex discrimination in higher education.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT:

- ✓ **AAUW Tech Trek Science Camp** is a week-long science camp at Stanford University designed for 7th grade girls featuring hands-on science and math activities. Yearly we fund 2-3 girls from our North Peninsula cities.
- ✓ **Lomita Park Elementary School** Volunteers from our Branch help children in this Millbrae school.

PUBLIC POLICY

- ✓ For more than a century AAUW has influenced legislative debate on critical issues such as: **Education, Social Security, Sex Discrimination, Civil Rights, Reproductive Choice, Affirmative Action, Title IX, Welfare Reform, Vocational Education, Pay Equity, Family and Medical Leave and Health Care Reform.** We work to increase the representation of women and minorities in policy making decisions.
